

Root Causes of Protocol Complexity



Growth of personalized oncology and rare disease studies



Use of advanced modalities (e.g., cell/gene therapy, radiopharmaceuticals)



Increasing endpoints, eligibility criteria, and clinical biomarkers



Logistical challenges (just-in-time manufacturing, global site variability)



Lack of early optimization and cross-functional alignment

Take a Multidimensional View Early

• Involve clinical, operational, regulatory, payer, and patient perspectives • Challenge assumptions during protocol design

Collaborate Early and Often
